DAILY HABITS OF LIVING THE LIFE OF AN OVERCOMER





1. RENEW YOUR MIND -Philippians 4:8

Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.

2. GIVE YOUR TITHE -Malachi 3:10

Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this," says the Lord of hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it.

3. FORGIVE THOSE THAT OFFEND YOU - Colossians 3:13

Bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.

4. HAVE AN ACTIVE PRAYER LIFE -

Jeremiah 29:12

Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you.

1 Thessalonian 5:17
Pray without ceasing.

5. STAY IN JOY -Nehemiah 8:10

Do not sorrow, for the joy of the Lord is your strength."

6. BE CONTINUALLY FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT -Ephesians 5:18

And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit.

7. STUDY GOD'S WORD - 2 Timothy 2:15

Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

8. PLEAD THE BLOOD Revelation 12:11

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives unto the death.

9. TURN FROM EVIL -Psalm 34:12-14

¹² Who is the man who desires life, and loves many days, that he may see good? ¹³ Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit. ¹⁴ Depart from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.

10. BE SLOW TO ANGER

He who is slow to anger is better than the mighty, and he who rules his spirit than he who takes a city.

11. BE A WORSHIPER- Psalm 29:2

Give unto the Lord the glory due to His name; Worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness.

12. WALK IN LOVE -Ephesians 5:2

And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma.



Do's and Don'ts

- Acknowledge the power and attributes of the Holy Spirit and seek them.
- Put on love and humility.
- · Have mercy and a heart for others.
- Have hope for a transformation.
- Believe the word, read it daily and let it take root in your heart with faith.
- Understand the power that raised Jesus from the dead and seated Him at God's right hand.
- Understand the exceeding greatness of His power towards those who believe.
- Understand the power of Jesus Christ at work in you.
- Understand that though crucified in weakness, He lives by God's power and though we too are weak, we also live by God's power and can do exploits through Him.
- Memorise scriptures and then use them as a weapon against evil forces of darkness.
- Ask God to clothe you with each piece of His armour everyday.
- The words you speak are seeds and will definitely produce that which you have sown.
- Confess victory in the face of apparent defeat.
- Focus on the dependability of God's word and not on the so-called reliability of mankind.
- Pray the promise, not the problem.
- Pray with your mouth for better concentration.
- Confess abundance in the face of apparent lack.
- Walk in His perfect will, not in His permissive will.
- Understand that the Spirit we have received is not of the world but of God, freely given to us by Him.
- Pray from the heart alone with God at every opportunity.
- Forgive others, be merciful. Often your situation will not change until your attitude changes.
- Honour God at every opportunity e.g. with your substance, with singing, dancing and exaltation.
- Find out His will for your life through prayer and obey without delay.
- Any form of disobedience blocks prayers (e.g. disobedience to the Lord, those in

- authority, parents etc).
- When in doubt, ask God first, before asking man.
- Seek His face in time, do not procrastinate.
- Put God first and yearn for His presence.
- Wait for an answer at the end of each prayer.
- Don't pray in a hurry unless in danger.
- Have an intimate walk with God, develop a relationship with Him.
- Enter into daily covenant prayer with Him (choose a convenient time).
- Commit your hopes and dreams in His hands.
- Look to Jesus to meet all of your needs.
- Put your expectations in the Lord and not in other things (e.g. money) or people.
- Keep your eyes on Jesus and listen to His still small voice.
- Ask God before taking major decisions.
- Let the joy of the Lord be your strength.
- Be patient, He is never late.
- Love others as He has loved you; pray for them.
- Give to those in need, etc.
- Have a place of solitude free from distraction in order to be alone with God.
- Pray with others (fellowship, etc.) and intercede for others.
- Put God in remembrance of His word.
- Build your life on His word and build His word into your life.
- Pray without ceasing (as often as possible throughout each day).
- Don't let anything keep you from your work and service to God.
- Be vigilant and do not be ignorant of satan's devices as he seeks whom to devour.
 (Everybody has enemies and his agents are real. They enter into living beings and objects and use them against others).
- Do not pray "return to sender prayers" but pray for God's mercy and deliverance of the victim satan is using. (God is not interested in the death of a sinner but in his repentance and deliverance).
- Give yourself communion from time to time.
- Continually plead the Blood of Jesus Christ over yourself, family, home, marriage and all that has to do with your life.

- Trust in God's unfailing love for you. His promises will always come to pass.
- Never doubt God's power. An unstable man will get nothing from Him.
- Count your blessings and name them one by one. He who has done those
 ones will do the rest.
- Pray the promise, not the problem.
- Sing praises to the Lord and hand over your worries and cares to Jesus
- Let God's word dominate your thoughts, cast down thoughts' contrary to His word.
- Remember that greater is God's word inside of you than the smaller trial facing you.
- · Stay humble.
- Be comforted in the fact that God desires to comfort you and heal your broken heart.
- Confess abundance in the face of apparent lack.
- Do not let the root of bitterness take a hold of your life. Rejoice always.
- Cry out to God in your distress, He is always available to rescue you.
- Give to those in need, despite your state. There are people who are in a worse situation than yourself.
- Never repay evil for evil, rather repay evil for good.
- Have a healthy relationship/fellowship with your Father, He is the source of strength for every trial or tribulation.
- Do not forsake the assembly of fellow believers, they will help you grow.
- Understand that we have been given the Spirit of God freely to help us navigate through life's challenges.




Prayer / Confession

Notes

Forgiveness is for our own growth and happiness. When we hold on to hurt, pain, resentment and anger it harms us far more than it harms the offender

Forgiveness frees us to live in the present. It allows us to move on without anger or contempt or seeking revenge.

To forgive someone is the highest, most beautiful form of love. You find a sense of peace and happiness when you do.

Forgiveness is not something we do for others - it's something we do for ourselves. Not forgiving someone is the equivalent of staying trapped in a jail cell of bitterness, serving time for someone else's crime.

When you are offended call out to the one who has offended you and calmly explain your feelings without anger. This will free you from bondage and free your heart from keeping grudges.







- The same Spirit that raised Jesus to life from death lives in me and gives life to my mortal body. Though my body will be immortal on His return, in the time being, I receive the life of God in my mortal body now.
- Jesus has redeemed me from every curse of the law, having become a curse for me because Your word says cursed is one who hangs on a tree (cross), therefore, no sickness or disease can dwell in my body or in my life.
- I claim the blessings of Abraham. My body is my dwelling place and my Father has promised that no evil or plague can come near my dwelling place and it is a living sacrifice which I present to God.
- The Lord has sent His word, healed me and delivered me from every form of destruction because He has promised to restore health to me and heal me of my wounds.
- The life of God quickens my mortal body, the Holy Spirit dwells in me, therefore, I command my body to stay in line with God's word. Every germ, bacteria and virus must die now in the name of Jesus. I command every form of sickness and disease in my body to die. Neither cancer nor tumours can live in my temple. All my vital organs line up with the word of God and I claim my healing now because I incline my ears and eyes to His sayings and

- keep them in my heart. They are life, health and healing to all my whole body.
- Jesus who went about doing good healed them; and because He is the same yesterday, today and forever, and because I refuse to doubt in my heart, He has healed me too today.
- According to Jesus' promise if I ask anything in His name, if I abide in Him and His words abide in me, it would be done for me; therefore I ask for His supernatural healing power upon me now.
- Son of righteousness, rise with healing in Your wings that I may be made free from every sickness and be delivered from every disease, that my joy may be full through You in Jesus name. Amen.

TO GET RESULTS:

- Always believe you have received when you pray, healing takes place immediately.
- Authority over sickness and disease does not come automatically, it must be enforced (by the power of the Holy Spirit).
- Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed because the prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.

- 4. Decide to be well.
- 5. God's words are health to all flesh.
- The word is God's medicine because it produces life and health in the body.
- Believing in healing is not enough, you must know it is God's will for you to be healed.

- 8. Be obedient to receive from God.
- Do not look at circumstances, situations or feelings that are contrary to your healing but look at God's word and pay attention to what He says.

Meditate

1 Chronicles 28:9

As for you, my son Solomon, know the God of your father, and serve Him with a loyal heart and with a willing mind; for the Lord searches all hearts and understands all the intent of the thoughts. If you seek Him, He will be found by you; but if you forsake Him, He will cast you off forever.

Deuteronomy 8:6

Therefore you shall keep the commandments of the Lord your God, to walk in His ways and to fear Him.

1 John 2:6

He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

King David gave his son Solomon principles to guide him through life. These same ideas are ones that any Christian parent would want to present to a child:

- 1. Get to know God personally
- 2. Learn God's commandments and discover what He wants you to do
- 3. Worship God with wholehearted devotion






