In Ephesians 4:31, Apostle Paul enumerated some of the vices that could result in domestic violence in the home and he advised us to put it away from us. The truth is that every couple will disagree at one point or the other in their marriages. In other words, couples that never have conflicts do not exist.

Unfortunately, conflicts if not resolved could lead to bitterness and uncontrolled anger, which ultimately end up in abuse.
