Welcome Message By Apostle Folorunso Alakija

I welcome you to September and our University of Marriage conference 2022. The theme for today's conference is "Bridging Marital Gaps", and our theme scripture is taken from Ephesians 5:21-29, which says,

"21 Submitting to one another in the fear of God. 22 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. 23 For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Saviour of the body. 24 Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything. 25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, 26 that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, 27 that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. 28 So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. 29 For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the church".

In the scripture, we just read, Apostle Paul instructed couples on how to prevent gaps in their marital relationships. As we all know, God is the architect of marriage and He desires that our marital bonds grow stronger as the years go by.

However, so many things can cause distances between couples. Examples are, lack of physical and emotional intimacy, financial issues, excessive career or business pursuits, prolonged illness, infidelity, infertility, interference from in-laws and other third parties and the list goes on and on.

So, to prevent marital gaps, it is advised that couples should put to practice the prescription of Apostle Paul in Ephesians 5:21-29 by,

1. Submitting to one other
2. Showing unconditional love to each other
3. Supporting and building each other up so that they become the best version of themselves
4. Refusing to allow the interference of third parties in their relationships and
5. Respecting one another.

If all these are carried out, their marriages will be exactly as God intended for it to be and they will enjoy a blissful relationship and if there are already gaps in their marriages, it will be mended and restored.

I decree and declare that our marriages will grow stronger and stronger in Jesus name. I come against every attack of the devil against our marriages and I prophesy healing and restoration to every strained relationship. Our marriages shall continually be a testimony to the glory of God and to the shame of the devil in Jesus' mighty name. Amen.

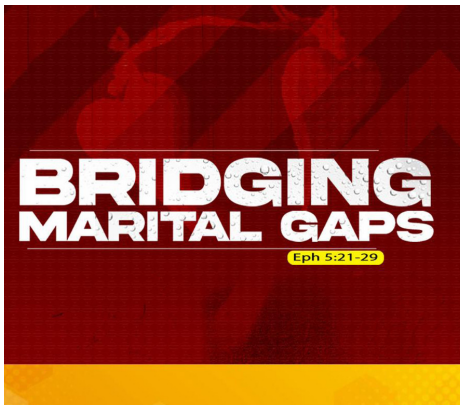
